Starting in September, the Sheriff's Office will host a fall session of the Citizens' Criminal Justice Academy.

During the course of the free, 12-week program, participants are not trained to be law enforcement officers, but are informed about each aspect of law enforcement. Participants learn about patrol operations, criminal investigations, court security, jail operations, community policing, and much more.

Participants will have hands-on participation including building searches, mock arrests, traffic stops and a trip to the firing range.
